CVS Pharmacy, Inc. has become increasingly concerned with escalating reports of prescription drug abuse in Florida, especially Oxycodone abuse. CVS will continue to review information relevant to this issue, and will alert you if CVS/pharmacy stores may fill these Schedule II narcotic controlled substance prescriptions in the future. However, you should expect that CVS/pharmacy stores will not be in a position to fill these prescriptions at this time.
